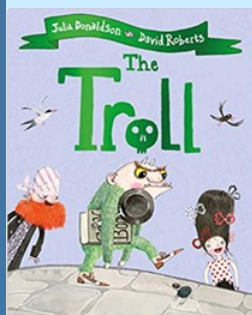
Dear Families, Staff and Volunteers

As we enter our final term of the academic year there are lots of exciting happenings including transition events. We work hard to make all moves as smooth as possible for the children, be that moving class or school.

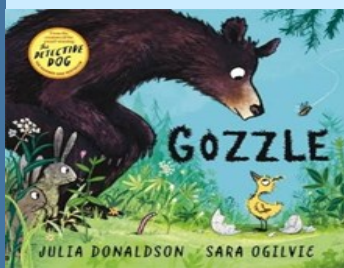
Wonderful Work!

KS1—the latest Julia Donaldson book.

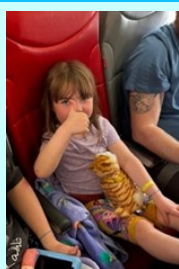


Here Comes The Sun (hopefully!)

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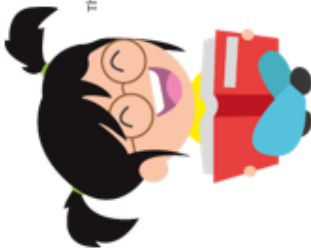

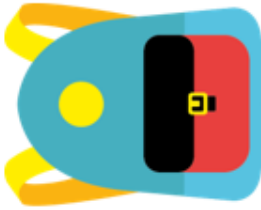
Coping with Anxiety
